

Frankenmuth Insurance Suspends Binding Authority Due to Tropical Storm Laura

As a result of the continued threat posed by Tropical Storm Laura in our Southeast region, Frankenmuth Insurance is suspending binding authority in Kentucky and Tennessee as of 5 p.m. Eastern Time on Thursday, Aug. 27.

This binding authority suspension will remain in effect until further notice and applies to new business as well as increases in limits or additions of coverage on in-force policies.

Home Office approval is required to override the suspension. We will continue to monitor the situation and inform you when the suspension is no longer in effect. Please contact your field manager or underwriter with any questions regarding this binding authority suspension.
